

BEVERLY AND RICHARD MONROE SCHOLARSHIP



This scholarship is given in memory of Beverly (Wilkinson) and Richard V Monroe, long-time residents of Little Genesee. Bev Monroe is remembered and loved as a bank teller at Key Bank. She was the Salutatorian of her 1950 class at Bolivar Central; she always wished that she had the funds to further her education. She worked as a secretary at Clark Brothers after graduation. Dick Monroe is also remembered and loved as a hardworking family man. He worked 37 years for National Fuel, was a 32nd Degree Mason, and a long-time member of the Shriners (and its car core-driving go-karts in local parades.) They were active members of the Bolivar United Methodist Church for decades.

Criteria:

- ❑ The student must: exhibit financial need and have earned a minimum GPA of a B/3.0 average at the end of the first year of study or at the conclusion of the program.
- ❑ Students must submit an application with a transcript and a list of extracurricular activities, and/or work experience (paid or unpaid), and/or volunteer experiences.
- ❑ The student must plan to attend any type of college or trade school full-time to study a vocational hands-on major. Examples: early childhood education, business, manufacturing, information technology, hospitality, culinary arts, health sciences, cosmetology, electrical trades, auto mechanics, plumbing, welding, criminal justice, construction, carpentry, professional assistant, HVAC, transportation/distribution logistics, etc.

Award Amount- \$5000.00 at the end of the first year of the program of study or completion of the program if less than one year in length with documentation of criteria met and approved.
