








Financial Aid Applications Document Checklist



Gather the following information prior to starting financial aid applications. Documents are required for both the participant & parent/guardian if the participant is under 24.

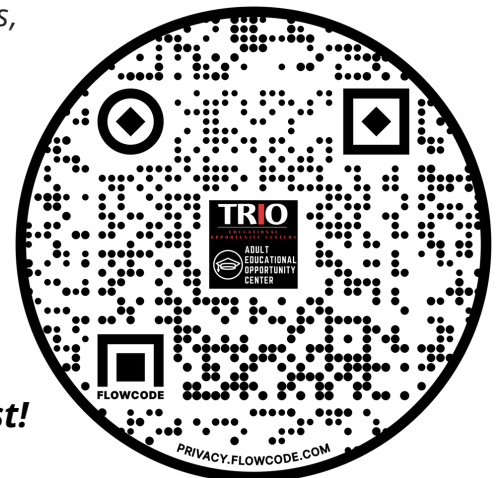
-  **Social Security Number**
(or A-number for non-citizens)
-  **Driver's License or Permit**
(If you have one)
-  **FSA ID and Password**
(Create at studentaid.gov - participant & parent/guardian need their own)
-  **IRS Form 1040 & NYS IT-201 from 2 Years Prior**
(Example: 2020 tax returns for receiving financial aid in 2022-23 year)
-  **Records of Untaxed Income**
(Child support, interest income, VA benefits, etc.)
-  **Records of Your Assets**
(Bank account balances, value of any investments, any real estate besides primary residence, etc.)
-  **Names of Schools of Interest**
