GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- * Safety to all staff, students, families, and the community is our #1 priority
 - *Limiting the length of time students are in masks (movement, flexible space and scheduling for students and staff)
- *Prioritize our most vulnerable people

NYSED MANDATES

- *Require face covering for all staff and students when unable to social distance
- *Protocols for daily health checks
- *Regularly clean/disinfect schools & buses
- *Promote hygiene & respiratory etiquette
- * Ensure educational equity, access, opportunity, quality, and support

- *Individual student needs will be prioritized
- *The district will develop instruction (in any model) that is accessible to all students

- *The district will support clear communication for how students and families can contact the school, teachers with questions about instruction or technology.

TEAM C: 	MS Special Education Classes will attend school in person Monday thru Friday
